## **Groups** Ice Breakers

- 1. **2 Truths & 1 lie** Participants list three things about themselves, two are true and one is a lie. Others must guess which is which.
- 2. Fun Fact participants will say a fun fact about themselves
- 3. **Name Association** Say your name and one word that begins with the first letter of your name to describe yourself... ex Crazy Chris:)
- 4. **Starbucks drink** There are a selection of drinks cold and hot and the person selects which one best describes them. For example a plain coffee or vanilla Frappuccino and they all have a certain meaning.
- 5. Who am I? Have group members wear the name of someone famous on their back and get people to help them guess who they are by asking questions.
- 6. **Candy game** Pick a candy with multiple colors.. Ex Skittles. Each color will represent different questions. Have each person pick a color and answer the question based on the color of the candy. Red- what's your favorite food, Orange what's your favorite TV show... etc.
- 7. **This or That** Have participants pick one of two options. For example would you rather be always cold or hot, or would you rather hear people's thoughts or predict futures.
- 8. **Coin game** You hand out coins randomly at the start of your meeting and for the year the coin was minted have each person share a special memory from that year.
- **9. People Bingo** Create bingo cards with a characteristic like "played a varsity sport" or "has a son" in each square. Everyone asks each other questions attempting to get a BINGO.
- 10. **TP Game** Pass a roll of toilet paper around the room and tell each person to take as much as they need. Then for each square they took, they must share a fact about themselves.
- 11. Thought provoking questions Simply go around the room asking each person their name and the answer to the same question.
  - a. If you were a brand, what would your slogan be?
  - b. If you could be an animal, what would it be?
  - c. If you could have a conversation with any famous person, dead or alive, who would you choose?
  - d. If you were given a million dollars to spend in a week, what would you do with it?
  - e. What was your favorite childhood game or activity?
  - f. What is your greatest fear?
  - g. What superpower would you wish to have?
  - h. What are your best talents?
  - i. What is your idea for the next great invention?
  - j. If you could travel anywhere, where would you go?
  - k. If you could interview someone from the Bible, who would it be and why?
